SCHOOL FEES FOR 2026

As required by the S.A. Schools Act (Act 84 of 1996) the budget for 2026 was presented, and approved, by the majority of parents at the budget meeting held on 5 November 2025.

SCHOOL FEE PAYMENT STRUCTURE:

2026 School Fees Amount to R 11 600 per learner, per year.

- Compulsory LTSM Payment: R600 per learner (*before 25 January 2026*)
***Note:** The compulsory LTSM payment of R600 for all learners will be used to purchase all learner writing books, textbooks and essential services/goods. The funds must be paid directly into the schools bank account.*
- Thereafter a monthly payment of R1 100 per learner for 10 months (*1st February – 1st November*)
- R1000 discount if payment is made before 31 December 2025 = R10 600
- R600 discount if payment is made before 31 March 2026 = R11 000
- No other discounts will be applied to the 2026 school fees

Both parents, father and mother and/or, where applicable, the guardian(s) of every learner are jointly and severally responsible for school fees in respect of such learner regardless of their marital status and whether any settlement agreement between the parents may exist, unless parents have applied and was also granted exemption or partial exemption of school fees.

Please note: A public school may enforce legal steps against parents/guardians in terms of Section 41 of the South African Schools Act, to enforce the payment of outstanding school fees. In such an event, you will be held liable for all legal costs incurred, as well as interest on the full outstanding amount, from the date of the notification until the date of final settlement.

School Fee Exemption

Please note that exemption forms may be collected and signed out at the office from TUESDAY, 20 JANUARY and returned before or on FRIDAY 20 FEBRUARY 2026. An exemption form can be collected and returned by a parent/adult. No forms will be handed to a learner. No forms will be accepted if returned by a learner. Parents need to apply for exemption every year. Learners in foster care automatically qualify for full school fee exemption. However, a school fee exemption form needs to be collected and completed annually.

Regular payment of school fees is essential to ensure and maintain a high standard of education. The payment of school fees is an investment in your child's future. Thank you for your co-operation and understanding.
